### Parents/Carers evening sign ups– CHANGE TO THE WAY APPOINTMENTS ARE MADE—PLEASE READ

We are using a new online system to enable you to book appointments to see your children's class teachers at a time which suits you. Parents evening will be held on **Wednesday 9th March 3.10pm to 5pm and Thursday 10th March 3.10pm to 7pm**. To book an appointment please . Go to [www.schoolinterviews.co.uk](http://www.schoolinterviews.co.uk) and follow these instructions.

1. Enter the event code given to you by the school for this event, which is **txxwv**
2. Enter your details-name, email address, child's name
3. Choose the relevant teacher/s for your child
4. Choose time

You can change your appointment bookings at any time prior to the closing date, by re-visiting the [www.schoolinterviews.co.uk](http://www.schoolinterviews.co.uk) website from the SAME COMPUTER you made the original booking on, and using the event code. Remember to use the same computer, name and email address, you used when you made your original booking.
