

Pupil Premium

What is Pupil Premium?

The pupil premium is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

Pupil premium funding is available to both mainstream and non-mainstream schools, such as special schools and pupil referral units. It is paid to schools according to the number of pupils who have been:

- Registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years (Ever 6)

In 2013 to 2014 schools received £900 for each eligible secondary-aged pupil

In 2014 to 2015 schools received £935 for each eligible secondary-aged pupil

Due to the fact that Pupil Premium can bring additional funding in order to support students, parents will always be encourage to claim Free School Meals if they are eligible.

Additional funding is also given to children who are Looked After by the Local Authority. This is £1900 per pupil and eligibility extended to include those who have been looked after for one day or more. Previously children had to be Looked After for a period of 6 months in order to qualify.

Children of Service personnel will receive additional funding of £300.

The percentage of students eligible for these additional levels of funding alters regularly due to the changing cohort of the population. The funding is allocated to the home school when a student is dual registered which significantly reduces the amount of funding available.

The figures for 2014-2015 are found below:

Braybrook - £935

Midpoint - £7,110
