I would like to take this opportunity to update you on our Year 11 Raising Attainment programme. The Raising Attainment programme has been developed to help ensure that every student in Year 11 receives the support they need in this crucial year of GCSE exams.

To help prepare you and your child, we have some important dates for your diary:

- **Second Year 11 Forecast -** will be completed in December 2017 - to be posted to parents .
- **Raising Attainment Sessions –** Fortnightly for all Year 11 students.
- **Revision Strategies –** Students will be given resources to help with their revision during Raising Attainment lessons.
