Dear Parent / Carer

I am delighted that your son / daughter has been allocated a place at Trinity Catholic College from September 2017 and would like to invite them to join us for two Induction Days on Tuesday 4th July and Wednesday 5th July. I would also like to invite you to one of our 'Parent Tours' of Trinity Catholic College on Tuesday 20th June or Wednesday 21st June, details of which are enclosed on the separate letter. I very much hope you will be able to take this opportunity to come along and experience our school during 'normal hours'.

Induction days help greatly in giving our new students an insight into what to expect when they arrive in September and hopefully help in calming those 'first day nerves'. Many Year 6 pupils have already visited us on several occasions thanks to our strong Primary School links and will therefore know quite a lot about our school day. For those who haven't already visited us, the Induction Days will prove invaluable by giving them the opportunity to experience two full days at Trinity Catholic College.

The Induction Days will start at 8.30 a.m. and finish at 2.30 p.m. during which your child will follow a programme of activities and lunch will be provided both days free of charge. On this occasion we ask that families make their own arrangements for getting their children to and from Trinity Catholic College. For health and safety reasons we are unable to allow your child to use the school buses on the Induction Days.

As part of our college's very strong pastoral care, your child will be introduced to their new Heads of Year and Form Teacher. This will be an ideal opportunity for your son / daughter to ask any questions or raise any concerns they may have about starting at Trinity Catholic College in September.

Finally, I would like to invite you to a Parents' Evening to be held on Wednesday 5th July at 7.00p.m. (**school will be open from 6.30pm**) when we will introduce our Year 7 Pastoral Team and other staff members. Our Parent Pack, which will be sent to you shortly, contains much of the information you need but the Parents' Evening will offer a further opportunity for you to raise any queries you may still have.

Parents will receive a full 'Year 6 Transition' information pack by the end of June; this will include transport and uniform details together with all the other important information you need for your son's/daughter's transition to Trinity Catholic College.
