

Edexcel ESOL Entry 1 - Level 2

Course Overview

ESOL is a course for students who have English as an additional language. If you have recently moved to this country and want to learn English to succeed in work or to move on to higher education this could be a good grounding for you! The course is available for school leavers and students up to 18 years old. As well as providing ESOL skills for life qualifications, it will give you the confidence to be able to communicate with others and progress in whatever you choose to do. When you start with us, you will be assessed on your level of English and you will be placed into the appropriate class.

Course Content

Pre-entry - Entry 3

- ESOL skills for life: Reading, Writing and Speaking & Listening
- Numeracy
- ICT
- General RE
- There will be periods of self- study, working on individual projects to enhance learning, time management skills and to encourage independent learning

ESOL level 1 and Level 2

- ESOL skills for life: Reading, Writing and Speaking & Listening
- GCSE Maths (If successfully passed Entry 1-3 Numeracy)
- General RE
- BTEC or selected A Levels may be an option depending on Literacy and Numeracy Levels

Assessment

Each level of Literacy qualification is assessed by 3 exams:

- Reading
- Writing
- Speaking & Listening

Each level of Numeracy qualification is assessed by an exam, focussing on: Number, Data and Shape & Space

Each Level of the ICT qualification is assessed by an exam

The exams are internally assessed and externally verified by the exam board.
