Reading

Children will be continuing with 'Reading Plus', exploring a variety of books and hopefully succeeding in reading 1,500,000 words as a class by Christmas!

Writing

Children will be writing up their narrative sport stories. They will also use Christmas as a theme for instructions and explanation texts.

Maths

Children will be working through a variety of topics this half term. Children will be developing their understanding of statistics, identifying properties of shapes, position and direction and area perimeter. Children will continue to access Times Table Rockstars to improve their times tables.

Science

In this half term the children will be learning all about 'Forces'. Children will identify forces and measure forces.

RE
