



Year 3 Newsletter



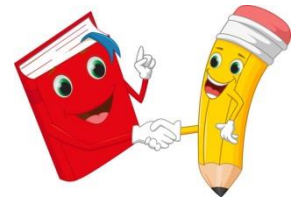
Welcome back to the new school year. We hope that you all had an amazing summer. We are all ready for the new school year and are looking forward to the year ahead.

In writing we are going to be learning about lots of new writing features and exploring family life stories, informal letters and persuasive writing.

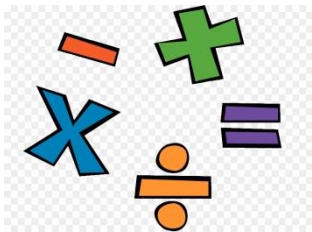
