Year 1 and Year 2 Phonics Screening

The children in Year 1 undertake a statutory phonics assessment in the summer term. The Year 1 phonics screening check is not a formal test; it is undertaken by the class teacher in an informal one to one setting. It is a way for teachers to ensure that children are making sufficient progress in the phonics skills to read words and are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. The school will report your child's results to you by the end of the summer term as well as to the local authority, but the results won't be published in a league table as with SATs.

Children who did not meet the expected standard in phonics at the end of Year 1 will be screened again in the summer term of Year 2.

If you have any concerns, do talk to your teacher about this in a parents' meeting, curriculum workshops or make an appointment after school.
