

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium.

- This financial year we have 32 children eligible for free school meals, this made up 15.8% of the school population.
- From this we received £40,926 in pupil premium funding.
- We used this money to provide targeted support for vulnerable groups across the school.
- We employed one teacher part time, 1 further HLTA and extended the hours of a learning support assistant to meet these needs.
- Free school meals children are tracked on a termly basis, and make up one of the focus groups in our 'Numbers into Action' meetings, where support is targeted for specific needs. This is done every term so that the support is up to date and relevant.

CLOSING THE GAP

- Our FSM numbers vary between cohorts with some classes approaching 25% FSM, with others at only 10%
- Our termly data shows that the FSM children are performing almost as well as the rest of the cohorts and are making similar progress.

- Our data shows that from the Autumn term, the FSM children are closing the gap on the rest of the cohort and indications show that the summer term data will follow a similar pattern.
