Year 4

Numeracy

Year 4's times tables this year will be x1-12. They will be tested frequently on this.

Literacy

In accordance with our 'Hook of a Book' programme, the children will approach a range of writing styles and the application of SPaG features through exciting texts.

R.E.

Liturgical celebrations run throughout the year for all children, including whole school mass, class liturgies, the Year of Oscar Romero, whole school liturgies and celebration mass.

P.E.

This year's PE units will include; Crystal Star Challenge, Furthest 5, Indian Delight, Long/Thin & Short/Fat, On the Attack and Partner Work

Throughout the year the children will visit a variety of units. This term, we will be covering:

- **Number: Place Value**
- **Number: Addition and Subtraction**
- **Multiplication and Division**
- **Measurement: Area**

This term, the children will be discovering the following texts:

- **Carousel Poetry** – Poetry and writing toolkits
- **The Dreamgiver** – Narratives, setting description and character description.
- **Tutankhamun** – Instruction writing and other forms of non-fiction

Crystal Star Challenge Furthest Five

These units will provide teamwork, individual development, will work on balance and coordination and will aid whole body control and precision.

Science

Throughout the year, the children will be taught how to work scientifically, applying such skills as communication, collaboration, analysis and working critically with evidence.

Living things and their Habitats

In this unit children explore a variety of ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. They learn how animals are split into 'vertebrates' and 'invertebrates' and begin to consider the differences between living things within these classifications.

Animals including Humans

This unit focuses on the digestive system in humans and animals and the functions of teeth. Children will learn more about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores in the context of teeth, digestion and the food chain.

Computing

E-Safety covered in depth during first term and revisited at the start of each following term.

We will focus on important computer skills needed for safe and effective computer use and introduce some further skills concerning the use of folders, searching for files and printing. We will introduce children to programming and algorithms through accessible means.

MFL

In French this year, the children will discover a wide range of speaking and listening techniques.

Les animaux Animals

At the end of this unit most children will be able to ask and answer questions about pets and other animals. They will learn to apply adjectives and write a simple description of their pet.

Creative Curriculum

Creative Curriculum is the umbrella term for the creative and humanities subjects, taught around a 'hook' during each half term.

Vicious Vikings

This unit will teach the children about the raids and invasions by Vikings in Anglo-Saxon Britain. They will learn about significant events from the period and the Anglo-Saxon kings who ruled, as well as culture and traditions from the age.
