<p><b>Numeracy</b></p> <p>The children will use concrete, pictorial and abstract representations to master maths concepts.</p>	<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>In accordance with our 'Hook of a Book' programme, the children will approach a range of writing styles and the application of SPaG features through exciting texts.</p>	<p><b>R.E.</b></p> <p>Liturgical celebrations run throughout the year for all children, including whole school mass, class liturgies, the Year of Oscar Romero, whole school liturgies and celebration mass.</p>	<p><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>This year's PE units will include; Calling the Shots, Crystal Star Challenge, Group Dynamics, Making the Grade, Pairs Play, Three Jump Challenge</p>

This term, we will be covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Number and Place Value</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Addition and Subtraction</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Multiplication and Division</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Fractions</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Position and Direction</a></li> </ul>	<p>This term, the children will be discovering the following texts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">A Murder Most Unladylike</a> – suspense writing, character descriptions, setting description, recounts</li> <li>• <a href="#">Kensuke's Kingdom</a> – adventure stories, diary entries, newspaper articles</li> </ul>	<p>This term, our R.E. topics will be as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Loving</a> – it is in the love of a family that most Christians first experience the reality of church.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Vocation &amp; Commitment</a> - all Christians are called to share the mission of Jesus.</li> <li>• <a href="#">Expectations</a> - understanding that Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus, given by God as a sign and expression of God's love</li> <li>• <a href="#">Judaism</a> - learning that Yom Kippur is probably the most important holiday of the Jewish year</li> </ul>	<p><b>Calling the Shots</b></p> <p>This involves children setting up a 4 v 4 invasion game based on mini-versions of football, netball, basketball, hockey, tag rugby, lacrosse or water polo.</p> <p><b>Crystal Star Challenge</b></p> <p>This core task involves children working in teams of five or six to navigate around the school site and complete problem-solving challenges within a set time.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Throughout the year, the children will be taught how to work scientifically', applying such skills as communication, collaboration, analysis and working critically with evidence.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>E-Safety covered in depth during first term and revisited at the start of each following term.</p>	<p><b>MFL</b></p> <p>In MFL, we will be working on our recognition, understanding and application of the French language.</p>	<p><b>Creative Curriculum</b></p> <p>Creative Curriculum is the umbrella term for the creative and humanities subjects, taught around a 'hook' during each half term.</p>
<p><b>Animals including Humans</b></p> <p>Children will build on their knowledge and understanding of different systems within the body; research the parts and functions of the circulatory system; focus on how nutrients are transported around the human body; explore how a healthy lifestyle supports the body to function and how different types of drugs affect the body.</p> <p><b>Light</b></p> <p>Children will learn about light, how we see, shadows, reflection and refraction. They will learn how light travels and how this enables us to see objects.</p>	<p><b>Website Design</b></p> <p>This unit will build on the children's prior knowledge of searching the Internet. The children will have the opportunity to learn how to create an entire website by first researching what makes a good website.</p> <p><b>Spreadsheets</b></p> <p>Children are given an understanding of spreadsheets and how they can be used.</p>	<p><b>Les Sports</b></p> <p>The children will learn what activities they like/dislike; recognise and respond to instructions including parts of the body; record simple daily activities in French and understand related written information.</p>	<p><b>Mayan Civilisation</b></p> <p>The children will learn about the history of the Mayans and their Gods and beliefs; Food; Number system; Achievements; and their daily lives. Following into the second part of the term we will be studying a whole school topic which is to be decided.</p>
