<p><b>Numeracy</b></p> <p>Year 3's times tables this year will be the, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.</p>	<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>In accordance with our 'Hook of a Book' programme, the children will approach a range of writing styles and the application of SPaG features through exciting texts.</p>	<p><b>R.E.</b></p> <p>Liturgical celebrations run throughout the year for all children, including whole school mass, class liturgies, whole school liturgies and celebration mass.</p>	<p><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>This year's PE units will include; Balancing Act, Furthest Five, Pass the Baton, Round the Clock, Run the Loop, and Three Touch Ball.</p>

Working on developing their flexibility, strength, technique, control, and balance.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Throughout the year, the children will be taught how to work scientifically', applying such skills as communication, collaboration, analysis and working critically with evidence.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>E-Safety covered in depth during first term and revisited at the start of each following term.</p>	<p><b>MFL</b></p> <p>In MFL, we will be working on our recognition, understanding and application of the French language.</p>	<p><b>Creative Curriculum</b></p> <p>Creative Curriculum is the umbrella term for the creative and humanities subjects, taught around a 'hook' during each half term.</p>
<p><b>Plants</b></p> <p>This term the children will be identifying the different functions of different parts of a flowering plant. They will also explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.</p>	<p><b>Processing skills</b></p> <p>In this unit, the children will be learning basic processing and computer skills. We will be learning how to log on, save our work and locate files. We will also be beginning to use our new school programme 'My Maths'. The focus of our ICT work will regularly link to our creative curriculum unit.</p>	<p><b>I can speak French!</b></p> <p>This term we will be focusing on Je parle francais (I can speak French!). We will be learning about France as a country and the cultural difference between France and the UK. We will also be learning simple classroom commands and numbers 0 – 12.</p>	<p><b>The History of our home</b></p> <p>In our first creative topic, we will be exploring the history of Newcastle and the nearby local area. We will learn about what it was like to work in the mines, we will be writing a diary entry of a child working in the mines, and create beautiful artwork inspired by the Angel of the North.</p>
