

## **Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium 2018 - 19**

**2017 - 18 Funding allocated: £13, 113**

**2017 - 18 Expenditure:       £10, 000 towards salary of Literacy plus co-ordinator  
  £3, 113 resources including chromebooks and ATA time**

### **Difference made to the pupils involved:**

In **September** there were **6 students** (2 earmarked did not attend)

**Reading ages: 8:04-10:07**

The group consisted of those who were disapplied, absent or scored less than 10/50 in end of KS2 reading.

None of the students had a statement but all had varying degrees of SEN, some behavioural issues.

After **February** 1 returned to mainstream with an **improvement in reading of 17 months.**

In March another student joined – RA 7:06

At the end summer term the remaining students are expected to return to mainstream.

**Average improvement in reading for those in for the academic year was 22.2 months.**

**For the newcomer RA improved by 11 months.**

Two students had attendance less than 75%, three greater than 90%.

The most improved member of the group was by 32 months.
