

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium 2017 - 18

2016 - 17 Funding allocated: £13, 113

**2016 - 17 Expenditure: £10, 000 towards salary of Literacy plus co-ordinator
£3, 113 resources including chromebooks and ATA time**

Difference made to students involved:

In **September** there were **14 students**

Reading ages: 7:01-13:09

The group consisted of those who were disapplied, absent or scored less than 10/50 in end of KS2 reading.

One student had a statement most of the others had varying degrees of SEN, some behavioural issues.

After **Christmas** 5 left the group – 4 returned to mainstream and one (eventually) left the school.

Average improvement in reading for these was 10.2 months.

After **Easter** one more returned to mainstream – **reading improvement was 16 months.**

In the summer term the remaining student returned to mainstream.

Average improvement in reading for these was 16.4 months.

One student, even though extra reading support was given, made limited progress with the test taken. However, there has been a marked improvement with confidence, attitude and skills at decoding words.

The most improved member of the group was by 28 months.
