



The Year 11 Prom Passport runs from 7th January 2019 until 17th May 2019 (15 school weeks). Students have to achieve 40 points over this period in order to attend the prom and can gain and lose points for the following:

Gain points	House Points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 point for every house point you receive. - House points will also be given for attendance to revision sessions attended before school, dinnertime, after school or in holidays - 1 point for attendance at each revision session (member of staff running the session will add house point into planner).
	Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 points for having between 95%-100% attendance. <i>Attendance points will be awarded over the fortnightly/ weekly period so 95% + attendance over this time will result in 3 prom points</i> - <i>Attendance will be allocated over a fortnightly period except for the following periods:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 7th - 11th January; and - and 11th - 15th February - <i>Attendance is not marked cumulatively; it starts again every fortnight/ week depending on the run period. This is to give all students the chance to gain prom points through good attendance to school.</i>
	Ambition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 points for every 'exceptional' on your PRP. - 1 point for every 'motivated' on your PRP.
Lose Points	Negative Entries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - -1 point for every negative point you receive.
	Ambition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - -1 point for every 'poor' on your PRP.

A report will run weekly totalling the number of positive and negative points you have received. Your number of points will be given to you on the following Tuesday dates:

- 15th January 2019 (including ambition points from PRP 2 in December)
- 29th January 2019
- 12th February 2019
- 26th February 2019
- 2th March 2019
- 26th March 2019 (including ambition points from PRP 3)
- 23rd April 2019
