Tuesday 31st March

- **Nursery and Reception**
- Nursery - Parents can collect their children from the Nursery entrance **from 2.45 pm onwards**. Entry to the Easter Fayre will be through the big hall doors beside the Nursery entrance. Sorry no prams allowed in the building.
- Reception - Parents can collect their Reception children from the **Nursery door at 3.20 pm**. Entrance to the Easter Fayre will be through the big hall doors beside the Nursery entrance. Sorry no prams allowed in the building.
- **Y1/Y2**
Children will be dismissed as usual at **3.20pm in the Infant yard**. They can then come into the hall with parents via the hall doors beside the Nursery entrance.
- Junior children will be dismissed at **3.30 pm** as usual. The hall will be open for viewing the eggs. Entry via the hall doors beside the Nursery entrance.

Wednesday 1st April

Parents of **Junior** children are invited to view the eggs in the school hall from **9.00am to 9.30am**. Entry via main doors.

Y3 – Y6

- Pupils in the Junior classes will be taken into the hall with their teacher to spend any money they have with them from **9.30am**.
