Dear Parents,

An educational visit relating to work in the History curriculum area has been arranged for children in Y5 to visit Washington Old Hall.

The children will go on the following days:

Y5PM	Monday, 27th April 2015
Y5SK	Tuesday, 28th April 2015
Y5MS	Wednesday, 29th April 2015

The theme of the visit is The Tudors. School uniform should be worn.

A tudor lunch will be provided for the children. This will consist of ham, cheese, bread and fruit. Those children who don't eat ham for religious reasons will be served without the ham on their plate.

Children with nut and food allergies only, must bring their own lunch preferably on a plate covered with cling film so that it is not handled by anyone other than themselves. Their food should also be ham, cheese, bread and fruit if possible.

The children will travel by coach. They will leave school at 9.30 am and return at approximately 3.30 pm

The cost per child will be £9.00 which includes coach travel and entrance fee (the PTA and School have subsidised this amount by 30%). Goody bags are available to buy at £2.00 each but must be pre-ordered. Please note, if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals you are eligible for a further subsidy and need only pay £5.00.

Please note that as a result of legislation under the 1988 Education Act, schools can no longer make a compulsory charge to cover the cost of travel for visits held during school hours.

Although there is no obligation to contribute, for the visit to take place it is necessary to ask you for your support in making voluntary contributions. If a substantial amount of voluntary parental contributions are not made the visit may have to be cancelled. The school is grateful for your support in this matter.
