



Year 2 Curriculum Information

Topics covered this half term include:

Science - Materials.

Computing – Using a keyboard to write text.

R.E. – Harvest and the stories Jesus told.

Art – Sunflowers by Van Gogh; Paul Klee's geometric art work; mixing colours.

Music – identifying instruments and keeping the beat.

P.E – Outdoor and indoor. Lesson times may vary therefore kit needs to be in school at all times.

Literacy

Some of the work covered in Literacy this half term will include:

Recognising and taking account of commas, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks when reading aloud with appropriate expression.

Using full stops, capital letters and question marks when writing a sentence.

Linking stories and events to their own experiences.

Recognising rhymes and rhythms within poems and stories.

Reading and writing instructions.

Reading information about Victorians.

Spellings Each Monday children will bring home a list of 10 spellings to learn for a test on Friday. You have received an information leaflet with spelling activities.

Mathematics

Some of the work covered in oral maths this half term will include

Counting in order from and back to at least 100.

Recall of doubles to $10 + 10$.

Numbers that are 1 or 10 more/less than a given two digit number ie. 1 less than 36, 10 more than 28.

Count on and back in steps of ten, two and one.

Learn 2x table

Some of the work covered in topic maths this half term will include

Reading and writing numbers to at least 100.

Compare and order numbers.

Partition 2 digit numbers into multiples of 10's and 1's eg. 37 is 3 tens and 7 units.

Make and talk about patterns using numbers and shapes.

Handling data and measures using standard and non-standard units.

Telling the time - o'clock and half past
