

Pupil Premium 2012-2013

The level of funding in 2012-2013 was £953 per pupil for FSM pupils and for pupils who have been in care for six months. A proportion is allocated for those children whose parents serve in the armed forces.

In 2013 at the end of KS1 the pupil premium (10% of year group) achieved the following:

In 2013 at the end of KS2 the pupil premium pupils (11% of the year group) achieved the following:

- In mathematics, reading and writing 100% made expected progress (2 levels), of which 50% made more than expected progress (3 levels) in mathematics and writing and 34% in reading.
