

Y3 Curriculum Information

Topics covered this half term include:

- Science – Magnetism.
- R.E. – Christmas customs from other lands including St. Lucia, the Christmas story.
- Geography – map work including features of the school and the locality, map symbols, compass directions and simple grid references
- Computing – Algorithms, simple coding. I pads – ‘Scratch’. Probot cars
- Art and Design – Christmas craft involving cutting, folding, using templates and collage.
- Design and Technology – cookery.
- Music – Christmas Performance ‘Magical Christmas Jigsaw’

Literacy

Some of the work covered in Literacy this half term will include

- Using a range of non-fiction texts eg. information books, writing reports and presenting information in a variety of ways.
- Identifying speech marks in reading and beginning to use them in their writing.
- Spellings – words with the suffix –ing, ful and adding –ed.
- Function of verbs and adjectives in a sentence.
- Letter writing

Mathematics

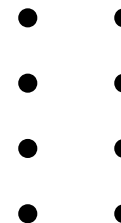
The pupils in Y3 are set for maths and the work is planned to meet the needs of the group. This is particularly the case in number work. Some of the work covered in oral maths this half term will include

- Counting on and back in 2’s, 10’s and 100’s.
- Multiplying by 10 and 100.
- Multiplying by 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8.

Some of the work covered in topic maths this half term will include

- Addition and Subtraction
- Fractions – $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{1}{10}$.
- Multiplication as repeated addition and arrays.

4 sets of 2 can be shown as
repeated addition $2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8$
or an array
