Literacy

Some of the work covered in Literacy this half term will include

- Alternative sounds 'ai', 'ie', 'oa', 'ee', 'ew', 'ou', 'er', 'ur', 'ir', 'wh', 'ph', 'kn', 'gn', 'tch', 'dge', 'wr', 'mb', 's', 'es'.
- Traditional Tales
- Retelling familiar stories
- Developing the use of capital letters and full stops
- Diary entries

Mathematics

Some of the work covered in oral maths this half term will include

- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's to 50/100.
- Counting on and back from a given number within 100
- Number bonds to 10/20.
- Estimation of up to 30 objects.
- Quick recall of numbers before, after and between.
- Time – o'clock, half past, quarter to / past
- Double and half numbers
- Recognising 2D and 3D shapes.

Some of the work covered in topic maths this half term will include

- Addition of a 2 digit number and a single digit number
- Addition of two 2 digit numbers
- Subtraction of a single digit number from a 2 digit number
- Solving problems involving addition and subtraction
- Name 2D and 3D shapes
- Comparing length, mass and weight
- Money
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ of amounts and shapes
- Position and direction
