Topics covered this term include:

Science – Forces – push and pull.

Computing – Creating pictures and text. Keyboard skills.
Coding

Art – 3D work using different papers and fabrics. The work of L.S Lowry

Music – Singing to the beat, exploring rhythms.

Geography – Features of cities and countries e.g. London, New York, Iceland.

Literacy

Some of the work covered in Literacy this term will include

- Poetry, including discussing favourite poems and poets and the language of poems using the theme of “Winter”.

- Instructional texts.
- Reading stories in order to understand main events and be able to form an opinion about characters and their actions using books by Alan Ahlberg..
- Phonic work – ow as in ‘snow’, ur, er, ir, ow, ou.
- Mary Seacole.
- Extending sentences using adjectives and connectives.

Mathematics

Some of the work covered in oral maths this term will include

- Pairs of numbers with a total of 20.
- Counting in steps of 5s, 10s and 100s from and back to zero, multiples of 10.
- Recall of doubles to 10+10 and corresponding halves.
- Finding the difference between two numbers.
- Sharing methods of solving problems with others.
- Adding and subtracting 10 from a given number up to 100.
- Adding multiples of 10 to 100 eg. 40 and how many more make 100.

Some of the work covered in topic maths this term will include

- Counting to 100 in 2's, 5's and 10's and relate to money.
- Partitioning 2 digit numbers eg. $46 = 40$ and 6 .
- Addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers.
- Multiplication and related division facts in 2, 5, and 10 x table
- Halving and doubling.
- Sort and describe 2D and 3D shapes.



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
