Student Reports and Parents Evenings

We have made some changes to the way we report student data this academic year.

Progress Reports

Progress Reports for all year groups will be published on line through the Go4Schools system (accessible via the college website) 4 times a year:

- QA1 – 17th November
- QA2 – 1st February
- QA3 – 27th April
- QA4 – 6th July

Yearly Reports

Yearly Reports with teacher comments will be made available on Parents Evenings with the exception of Year 11 who will receive a Mock Exam Report on Parents Evening and a Yearly Report by post late March.

Report Content

Years 7 and 8: Progress is shown by comparing the student's Current Attainment against their End of Year 8 Target.

Current Attainment is shown using a scale of 1-4:

1. Student is currently exceeding expectations and making excellent progress
2. Student is currently meeting expectations and making good progress
3. Student is currently working below expectations and requires improvement
4. There is currently insufficient data to make a judgement on the student's progress


Years 9, 10 and 11: Progress is shown by comparing the QA Attainment (current attainment) against the student's target. Students have two targets a National Median Target, the bare minimum the government expects students to achieve and a more challenging Aspirational Progress 8 Target also set by government that we hope students will achieve. A teacher prediction for the end of Y11 GCSE will also be available.

Parents Evenings

- Y9 – 1st February (including the Options Process)
- Y8 – 15th March
- Y10 – 3rd May
- Y7 – 28 June
