

How to Access GO 4 Schools System

Academic Year 2018-19

Dear Parent/Carer

Using GO 4 Schools, you will be able to view your child's progress online and access the following information at any time:


- **Real-time attainment information** – marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
- **Attendance Summary** – Shown from the start of the academic year
- **Timetable** – Your child's daily and weekly timetable
- **Progress Reports** – Published 3 times a year. Yearly Reports are provided in hard copy format, usually on Parents Evenings
- **Behaviour information**

Your child's page is constantly updated, providing you with the latest information. To access the site, please go to the college website, Parents & Carers section, GO 4 Schools and click on the link for the GO 4 Schools login in screen.

The email address you use to enter the site must be the one you have registered with the College. If you wish to change your email, notify the College who will update your details. The information will feed overnight from the College SIMS system into the GO 4 Schools system.


Please note, GO 4 Schools will pick up parental emails overnight for those parents with parental responsibility. Parents with court orders will not be able to access GO 4 Schools.

To request a password for GO 4 Schools, please enter your email address into the First-time User field and click 'Please send me a password'. A randomised password will then be generated and sent to your email address. You will then be able to log into the site and view your child's page.

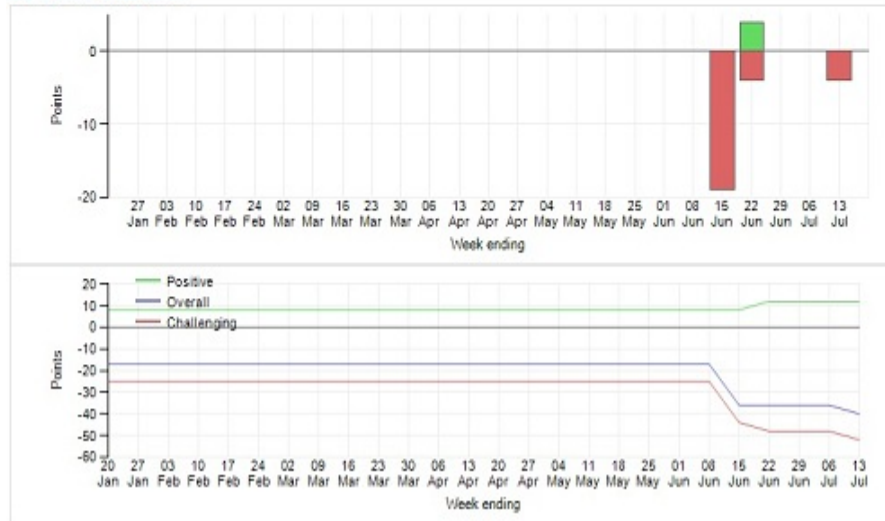
