I can write a paragraph made up of short and some longer sentences using taught language, which may have errors. I can translate short phrases from English, containing all familiar language from the most recent topic.

I can cope with some unfamiliar language in a variety of text types. I can understand time frames and infer meaning.

I can write longer paragraphs on one or more topics, with good accuracy. I can adapt known structures with some inaccuracy and translate short sentences from English across one or more topics.
