



KS2 Data for 2017

Dear Parents and Carers

I have detailed below the data for end of KS2 for July 2017 however there were major changes in 2016 and the data does look different to previous years. In 2016 and 2017 the children were assessed against a set of end of year expectations and not a level, children either met expectations (EXS), were still working towards the standard (WTS), were working at greater depth (GDP) or not at the standard (NS).

Fellgate is unique in that we have many children who cannot access the tests, the children in the base. However, the Department for Education insists that all children are included in the school reported data and not just mainstream, as with other schools. The data reported publicly includes all pupils and doesn't reflect publicly the achievements of our mainstream pupils.

We are always very proud of the achievements of all our pupils at Fellgate, and this will continue despite any public representations to the contrary.

I have tabled the results below to show the data that is reported, the data that includes all pupil, and then the data for mainstream with comparisons to the national data for 2017.
