Who We Are



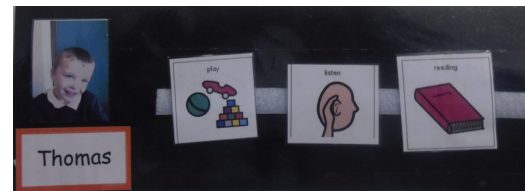
Fellgate Autistic Base is an attached specialist resource provision which is part of Fellgate Primary school. We educate 39 children in six classes, who are aged 3-11, and whose needs are complex and profound as a result of having a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Disorders.



What We Do

We provide personalised learning for all pupils, we take into account their behaviour, social and emotional difficulties and provide a holistic approach. We provide children with meaningful experiences and make learning inclusive engaging, challenging and fun!

We work together with speech and language therapy services and have a specialist communication champion who supports and delivers communication programmes. We assess children regularly to ensure they make progress against their own starting points. We also complete sensory profiles in order to consider the impact children's sensory needs may have on their learning this holistic approach links to our work using the SCERTS model (social communication, emotional regulation and transactional support).
