Hazels - Chester for a super attitude. He always goes that extra mile challenging himself to be the best he can be!

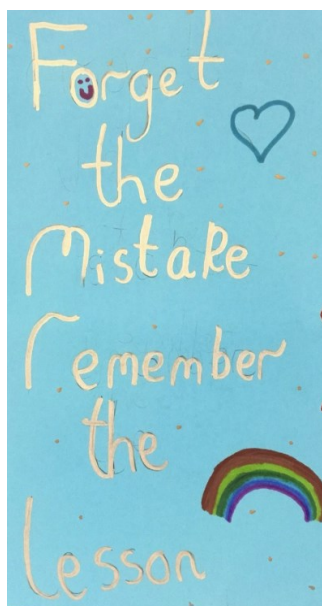
Maples - Caitlin for her super attitude. She is making progress with her learning in all subjects!
