

How does the world know about Chocolate? Year 3/4 Autumn Term

As **WRITERS**—our term will be spent focussing on Charlie and the Chocolate factory where we will be doing some amazing and interesting work. We will be carrying out film reviews, writing newspaper reports and writing our own chapters to Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will also be creating our own adverts, writing reports and doing some poetry.

As **READERS** we will be clarifying new words, making predictions and summarising what we have read. We will be asking and answering questions about what we are reading. We will be completing our Reading Journals at home, aiming to read a minimum of 3 times a week.

In **P.E**—Year 3 will be having Hull FC in to do rugby coaching as well as gymnastics in the first Autumn term. During the second half term they will be doing hockey and dance. Year 4, Miss Cotson's class will be going swimming and Mr Sutton's will be doing dance and outdoor games. Mrs Sutton's class will start swimming late November.

As **ARTISTS** we will be exploring realist and cubist compositions. Within this work, we will be looking closely at the use of geometric shapes and fragmented lines which will help us create our own 'sweet inspired' compositions!



In **DESIGN TECHNOLOGY** we will be exploring a variety of chocolate packaging and analysing the range of different bars and products which we either like or dislike. We will be conducting our own market research to find out who the target audience is for particular products, and will also explore the pricing and costs of chocolate production. We will then be using this information to design our own chocolate products and recipes for them!

In **R.E**—we will be focussing on remembering and the different beliefs in communities.

In **PSHCE**—we will be looking at the topic 'being me in my world' where we will be celebrating our differences.

City of Culture—During this autumn term, we will begin our 'Tell the World' season and will be learning immersively through links to the text; 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'



As **SCIENTISTS** we will be closely investigating sound and understanding how different sounds are created. We will explore how vibrations create and determine a variety of sounds, and we will be conducting our own experiment to investigate how far we can make sound travel. We will also explore both natural and man-made light sources and how these can be used to create shadows. We will be creating our very own pin hole cameras and telling the story of 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' through shadow puppets! We will also be learning about the sun as a light source and will be exploring how to stay safe when exposed to the sun's rays.

As **MATHEMATICIANS** - we will be learning all about number and place value, we will be learning all of the four operations and how to solve problems using them. We will also be looking at area and perimeter.

In **COMPUTING** - we will be learning all of the basic functions and programmes on a laptop through J2e. We will be using i-pads and the internet to research topics and creating QR codes to share what we have found out. We will be making our own radio and TV adverts too!
