## Provision for Pupils Eligible for Pupil Premium

At St Michael's Academy we recognise that children face many barriers to their learning. It is part of our ethos that these are effectively and efficiently removed so that all children make excellent progress. An integral part of this work surrounds the use of our Pupil Premium money which is allocated to children who are currently known to be eligible for FSM (or have been eligible in the previous 6 years) and children who have been looked after continuously for more than 6 months.

<u>The funding from Pupil premium has been allocated in the following ways:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• HLTA salaries for targeted maths &amp; reading boosting sessions for identified pupils in Y1,2,3</li><li>• Intervention group leader (Newly appointed TA) for targeted phonics &amp; Maths catch up for Year 1 &amp; 2 pupils.</li><li>• Booster groups – provided by 6 teachers &amp; TAs</li><li>• Subsidising school trips for 17 pupils</li><li>• Attendance on vulnerable families CPD for 2 Teaching Assistants: £100</li><li>• Attendance on WSCB toxic trio course for 1 Teacher = £50</li><li>• Weekly art therapy sessions for 2 pupils</li><li>• Weekly Bamhs sessions for 4 pupils</li></ul>

The gaps between progress at St Michael's and national averages show :-

At KS2:- Disadvantaged pupils' combined RWM APS = 28.1 **0.9** above National

At KS1 :- Disadvantaged Pupils in Combined Subjects APS was **-1.5 below National APS**. The greatest gap between non disadvantaged & disadvantaged was in **Reading -1.8**
