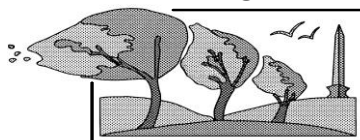

Please see your child's end of Year 11 targets based on their end of Key Stage 2 Average. We will report on the progress they are currently making towards their Y11 GCSE targets for each subject. The targets are aspirational to ensure that Court Fields students make better progress than students nationally from the same starting point. These targets will only be possible if they work as hard as they can and follow the advice from their teacher at all times.

Progress: the definitions below are used to describe Progress towards Target:

- P+ : Better than Expected Progress
- P : Expected Progress
- P- : Below Expected Progress

We also report on your child's effort grades for Attitude to Learning and Homework. Please read these carefully as they will give a good indication of how well they are currently working and their chances of achieving their targets.

Effort: A 4 point scale is used to describe Attitude to Learning and Homework:

- 1 Exceptional
- 2 Good
- 3 Acceptable
- 4 Cause for concern

Grades in certain subjects which have only been started recently may be lower than for Core subjects at this stage. If you have any concerns then you should see the subject teacher in the first instance so that you are aware of what your child needs to do to ensure they meet their target. You could also discuss this with their tutor. You will receive a final summary at the end of the year.
