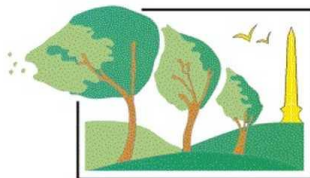

Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to welcome your son/daughter and yourselves to Court Fields School in September and look forward to working with you over the next five years. Care, guidance and support are strengths of the school and the students here tell us that they are very happy and feel safe.

At Court Fields, we have the highest aspirations for our students and aim for the best academic outcome for every child.

I will be visiting your son/daughter's Primary School during the Summer Term to meet your son/daughter and his/her class teacher. This will give me an opportunity to find out about your son/daughter's educational achievement and discuss with the class teacher his/her interests and abilities. The information gained will be used to help our teaching staff to plan appropriate programmes of work for your son/daughter and to place him/her in the most appropriate teaching groups.

Students who have particular talents will be identified in order that extension tasks are available in lessons and opportunities outside the classroom to further develop their talent. Those students who will need additional learning support will be assessed before transfer so that they can be supported by members of the Learning Support Department.

The children will visit Court Fields on **Tuesday 3rd and Wednesday 4th July for our 'Welcome Days'** – on the first day the children will be allocated to a House (Emerald, Ruby, Sapphire and Topaz) and Tutor Group. This is an exciting day to meet new students, teachers and experience what it will be like being part of the Court Fields School community in September. Year 8 students will be involved during the two days, helping and supporting our new Year 7 students.

On the second day the children will experience a range of tasks in subject areas. **There will be a Year 6 Parents and Carers meeting on the evening of Wednesday 4th July starting at 6pm, this will be an opportunity to receive more information about starting in September.**

We are looking forward to meeting you and working with you over the next five years to ensure your son/daughter makes the best of the excellent opportunities offered at Court Fields School.
