



PE Sporting Grant 2014-15

Estimated allocated grant - £8630 Proposed spending costs

SLA Hebburn Cluster

This is a Service Level Agreement between local primary schools in the Hebburn and Jarrow area, which includes quality coaches in basketball, gymnastics, tag rugby, Gaelic football, cricket and athletics. These coaching sessions culminate in a tournament for the children to compete in against other schools. The coaching is to provide support to improve curriculum teaching to ensure teachers' skills are developed and a sustainable improvement is achieved.

Cost: £3700 (SLA)

Cost: £300 (Transport for festivals)

New CPD scheme of work resources pack for teaching staff

This is needed to develop teaching and learning in PE linked to the new curriculum. This will ensure staff are confident in delivering the new curriculum from EY to Y6, and that this is consistent across the school.

Cost: £2195+VAT

South Tyneside SLA

Although we are not signed up for the SLA with South Tyneside, we have the option of 'buying into' sporting festivals/tournaments at £150. We will enter a KS1 and a KS2 competition during the year.

Cost: £300 (+ £50 transport)

South Tyneside also offers CPD courses at £300 each for the following seven areas: Gym, Dance, Striking/Fielding, Net Wall, Outdoor Adventure, Invasion. We plan on attending at least two of these courses for staff CPD

Cost: £600

Equipment

Essential lunchtime equipment and secure storage facilities for children to use at lunchtime, during the change4life programme.

Cost: £600

PE resources and equipment

Essential new equipment to cover a wide range of sports, particularly in KS2, such as tennis and badminton nets, rackets and balls; athletics equipment such as soft javelins, hurdles
