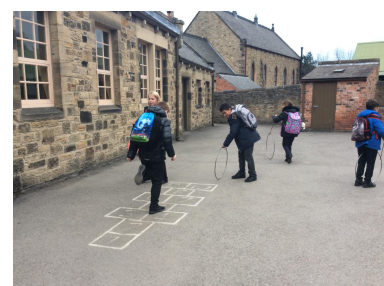
Year 5 Beamish Visit
