We are grateful for any help from you to:

- **Reading:** listen to your child read regularly as well as encouraging your child to read independently. We advise any books you read together are slightly more challenging than the child's independent ability. For example, a novel such as Narnia. Also, we advise that your child aims to read for at least 20 minutes per day.
- **Maths:** encourage your child to learn the times tables off by heart and the related division facts. We are learning the times tables in this particular order: 10s, 5s, 2s, 3s, 4s, 8s (followed by the other tables in no particular order).
- **Homework:** ensure your child completes homework early or on time and brings equipment needed to school on the correct day. For example, reading book and diary, spelling book, PE kit, swimming kit etc. Your child will be given maths homework every Friday to be returned to their teacher by Tuesday morning. This work is based upon the weeks learning and your child's teacher believes they are able to complete it independently.
- **Spelling:** practise their spellings. Your child will receive new spellings each week in their spelling books (3JL: Monday and 3KL: Tuesday) and the test will take place the same day. The initial learning of the spelling rules will be completed in school but practise will need to continue at home also. Please ensure their spelling books are looked after.
- **PE:** Games will take place every Monday afternoon. Your child will need a kit suitable for outdoors. Please make sure they have tracksuit/jogging bottoms and a t-shirt, trainers (not plimsolls) and a jumper, tracksuit top or hoodie. Swimming will take place in the Summer term.
