The Government grant for the Academic Year 2016 – 2017 for St Teresa's Catholic Primary Academy is: £8,795

Government guidance on how the funding can be used to improve the provision of Sporting Activities for pupils has been followed. At St Teresa's we have used the funding to:

- Make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport we offer by:
- Employing Specialists coaches to lead PE lessons which our Teachers observe and develop their own coaching skills in order to sustain the highest quality of provision throughout the Academy.
- Fund additional after school sports clubs to extend the range of activities available for pupils on a regular basis which are led by specialist coaches.
- Fund the cost of Activity Centre Activities to enable pupils in specific year groups to experience a wider range of physical activity led by experienced and qualified staff.
- Implementing targeted sports groups to help children to develop healthier lifestyles through engagement in appropriate and regular physical activity.
- Fund the additional costs of participating in out of school sports events within the local community
- Improving the range of sporting equipment available for use at playtimes and dinner times in order to enable children to access quality physical play throughout the day.
