Year 10 End of Year exams


The end of year AFA4 (achievement for all) exams are fast approaching. The purpose of these exams is to help prepare students for their final GCSEs; they are an important milestone in assessing how much progress your child has made. Students will sit an exam in every subject, with at least one of those papers in the sports hall, auditorium or library. We try as much as is practical to replicate what it will be like under real exam conditions when they sit their final exams.

Your child's teachers will have set the in-class assessment dates on [Show My Homework](#) as well as home learning to support their revision.
