Year 3/4 Residential Visit 2018: Boggle Hole

Dear Parents

We are organising an overnight residential visit for Year 3 and 4 children staying at Boggle Hole Youth Hostel from **1st - 2nd July 2018**. Children will leave school at 8.30am on Sunday 1st and return at approximately 5.30pm on the Monday.

The hostel is nestled in a beautiful cove along the Cleveland Way, a short walk from Robin Hood's Bay. It is a recently refurbished hostel with excellent facilities.

Linking to their science work on rocks, the children will be taking part in environmental workshops at The Old Coastguards House and have a guided fossil hunt along the shoreline. Mrs Stearne is currently completing her Coastal School Leader accreditation and will be leading a number of additional beach based activities including rock pooling and tide safety. On the Sunday evening, the youth hostel are hosting a pirate party for us.

Residential visits are a valuable part of a child's social and educational experience and in order to make this more affordable for parents we have minimised costs as far as possible. The cost to parents will be **£70** and includes **transport, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities**. Children will just need to bring a packed lunch on the Sunday.

To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of **£10** will be required. Please let the office know if your child will be taking part or not by **Friday 15th December** along with the deposit, preferably by bank transfer. The remaining cost can be paid in instalments of your choice with the final payment being made by **Friday 11th May** in line with our final payment to the hostel.
