### Main Hazards Are:

AS WITH ALL CASES OF INCREASED EXERTION DURING EXERCISE; THERE IS AN INCREASED RISK OF CARDIAC ARREST.

- Public Football Use 3G Pitch  
Injury to users caused by;
  - Bad / late tackles on opponents
  - Ankle & knee injuries sustained by going over on ankles or twisting knees
  - Wrist / arm / head / neck injuries sustained in slips, trips or falls
  - Head and neck injuries sustained by elbow / hands / arms in the face or balls to the face
  - Wrist / hand / arm injuries sustained in goalkeeping incidents (i.e. blocking shots)
  - Injuries sustained by collision with the goals
  - Injuries sustained by collision with other players
  - Muscular strain / sprain / tear
  - Bruising / grazes / cuts / lacerations resulting from falls / tackles or collisions
  - not taking a water bottle to remain hydrated throughout the class
  - Not taking a break if required during bouts of high intensity work
  - Physical violence / assault

- Member of staff
- Member of public
- Spectator
- Contractor
- Elderly
- Expectant mother or post natal mother
- Disabled person

<p><b>Existing Control Measures:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Annual maintenance service agreement in place for outdoor pitches which includes quarterly service visits to site.</li> <li>• Lettings Manager Visual checks which are once per day.</li> <li>• Department NOP &amp; EAP documents which instruct how to complete checks and how to react to incidents / emergencies.</li> <li>• Participants are checked for correct footwear (No blades)</li> <li>• Signage on footwear displayed in changing area and supplied to letting clubs.</li> <li>• Shin Pads must be worn at all times.</li> <li>• H&amp;S Training which encompasses all EAP actions.</li> <li>• First Aid at Work &amp; defib qualified staff on duty at all times.</li> <li>• Defib Present &amp; training required</li> <li>• No unsupervised moving of goal posts</li> </ul>	<p><b>Existing PPE:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shin Pads</li> </ul>
