RE: COMBINED GCSE AND A LEVEL GEOGRAPHY FIELD TRIP TO ICELAND: 20 – 23 SEPTEMBER 2019

We are delighted to announce that the Geography department will be running a trip to Iceland. The trip will be an unforgettable opportunity for students to experience Geography first-hand, supporting their classroom learning and bringing the subject to life.

The trip is being organised by specialist group tour operator Rayburn Tours who have been operating educational trips for schools since 1965. Rayburn Tours is ABTA bonded and ATOL protected, as well as being accredited by Learning Outside the Classroom and the School Travel Forum.

The aim of the trip is to improve understanding of the hazards topic that your son is studying as part of his GCSE or A Level course. Iceland marks the boundary of two tectonic plates and students will see first-hand many of the processes and landforms associated with this environment.

We will fly from Heathrow to Reykjavik and will be staying in the Husid Guesthouse on a full-board basis. From there we will explore many of Iceland's key tourist attractions by coach with our own personalised study guide. Excursions include the Secret Lagoon, Lava Centre, Golden Circle tour, South Coast tour and Reykjanes Peninsula. Further details are provided in the table overleaf.

The group will depart on Friday 20 September and return on Monday 23 September 2019.

The proposed cost of the trip is £725 and it is open to students currently studying geography in year 10 and year 12.

If you would like your son to take part in this trip, could you please make a **£150 non-refundable deposit via ParentPay by 15 October 2018**, and follow the schedule of payments outlined in the table overleaf to pay the balance. Please note that the School reserves the right to refuse a pupil a place on this trip based on poor behaviour at school or a concern relating to responsibility.
