Year 13 update

I am writing to keep you updated on developments in Year 13 as students approach the final terms at Enfield Grammar.

Key dates for Year 13 -reminders

The table below highlights important dates throughout year. Please take note of the Pre Public Examinations in March. All students need to be fully prepared. A timetable has been shared on google classroom.

March PPE

Thank you to those parents who attended target parents evening for identified red students and for your continuing support, in ensuring good pupil attendance and effort as we approach the final term. The Pre Public Exams start on Monday 4 March. Marks will be shared with students in lessons as soon as marking is completed, but I aim to provide all results for students to take home week commencing the 25 March. Results will also be available on Go for Schools. We have the Year 13 Parents evening in the same week.

Tutors will meet students and we will be working with target groups which will include some meetings with parents. Some students will also be placed in additional study sessions after school as we are concerned about the amount of hours students are not spending on working towards the final exams. The school is always open to students to stay in the sixth form house until 6pm each day.

Parents Evening

The final parents evening will be on Thursday 28th March from 4.30pm -7.30pm in the Upper School. We really want to see every student with a parent/carer to discuss the PPE results and areas to develop before the final summer examinations. Some students will be directed to meet with either Mr Berkkun or Ms Igbokwe – parents will receive a text. Students can collect an appointment sheet from the sixth form house.

Easter Revision

Revision sessions are running between Tuesday 9 and Friday 8 April. There will be two sessions times each day, 9am-11am and 11.15-1.15pm. Invited students will be sent a text with time of each session. If your son is invited, then I ask for your support in ensuring he attends. I will also share with students an Easter Revision Planner so they can make the best use of this critical revision time.

My recommendation to students is to treat each day as a school day and using the lesson times in school as a guide (with a 5-10-minute break, a short burst of exercise aids concentration, rather than the TV). This way students can divide up the day between subjects and topics.

Student Folders and attendance

We will soon complete another 'Folders/Book Look' and randomly selected students will be asked to bring in all their folders. Please support your son by asking to see their folders. A good, well organised and up to date folder will support better final grades. It is essential that students are in all lessons – students below target often have a poor attendance.

UCAS applications and Non University Pathways

The UCAS deadline has now passed. Students who have not yet accepted an offer are advised to wait until after their PPE results and we will advise students. The UCAS website has really useful videos explaining the options students have once offers are made. Any questions please contact me at school.
