



### Learning Adventure Tasks:

- Write a detailed diary account for one day in the life of one of the following: a worker for a logging company OR a worker on a cacao plantation (your choice whether it supports Fairtrade or not).
- Make a food diary and record how much you buy and eat that is Fairtrade.
- Imagine a future scenario, in 500 years, in which the world has lost many of its forests. Many ecosystems have been lost forever. What happened? How and why did the forests disappear? Write a story—use the *present tense* to describe the landscape; use the *past tense* to describe what happened.
- What do trees mean to me? Present why trees are important to you and how you feel about deforestation in a way of your choice. For example, you might write a poem or a song, you might present with ICT or create a model labelled with your thoughts and feelings.
- Create your own advertising campaign for Fair Trade.
- Decide whether you are for or against deforestation and write a persuasive letter to the Brazilian Government detailing your point of view.

### RE Tasks:

- Create your own Nativity Crib Set.
- Imagine that you are Mary or Joseph. Write about events at that first Christmas from your point of view.
- Write a prayer for all at Christmas.
