Maths

We will be focusing on calculating, starting with subtraction and then focusing on multiplication and short division. We will also do some work on measures and 2D shape.

PE

We will be working on tag rugby next term and working on Dances linked to our rainforest Learning Adventure.

Modern Foreign Languages

We will continue learning French. Our topic will be 'myself and my family'. The children will be talking and writing about themselves and listening to each other.

RE

Protect that Rainforest!



Literacy

We will continue reading and basing our writing on Journey to the River Sea. After that, we will look at Varmints and link this to our work on rainforest protection.

We will start working on Newspaper reports.

Science

We will finish our topic from Term 1, covering adaptation, fossils and microorganisms before moving on to a linked topic: Animals including humans, where we look particularly at the circulatory system.



Geography

We will think about and research fair trade and human rights. We will look at deforestation and how to protect the rainforest.

Art/DT
