

### **Discrete Learning**

#### **Maths**

We will be focusing on shape including area, perimeter, volume and coordinates. We will be learning long division for dividing by larger numbers and doing some work on data.

#### **PE**

We will start looking at OAA skills, working alongside teachers from Premier Sports.

#### **Modern Foreign Languages**

We will continue learning French. Our topic will be based around the book 'Grand Monstre Vert'.

#### **RE**

We will be completing our unit on Easter and the Resurrection. This will start with a 'Godly Play' and will consider the different feelings experienced by the women who discovered the empty tomb.

Our Learning Adventure will be:

**ANCIENT WONDERS!**

A study of Ancient Egypt



### Literacy

We will start by focusing on using figurative language in descriptive writing.

We will be working with the book 'Way Home' by Libby Hathorn.

We will continue with poetry using poems from the book 'Sensational' and begin to look at look at biography if there's time!

### Computing

We will focus on presenting PowerPoint suitable for the subject and the audience, adding background colours, pictures and sound.

If time, we may also introduce some 'coding'.

### PSHE

We will be covering a unit of work called 'Healthy Me'. This looks at the importance of food and exercise, the effects of drugs and alcohol and ends with emotional wellbeing.

### Geography

Children will be finding out about geographical features of Ancient Egypt and do some map work, including comparing ancient maps with that location today and finding out why changes may have occurred.

### History

We will be studying Ancient Egypt and look at how we use artefacts to find out about a historical culture.



### Science

We will be re-capping work on electricity from Year 4 and using switches to create more complex circuits. We will be drawing circuit diagrams and be able to explain whether a circuit will work or not and why.

### DT

Children will continue to work through the 'Phunky Food' program focusing on following recipes and making food.



### Outdoor Learning

We plan to use the outdoor space throughout the curriculum where appropriate and weather permitting.
