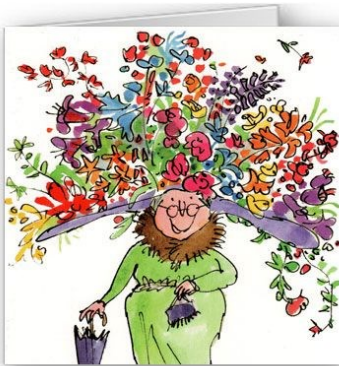

## Art and DT

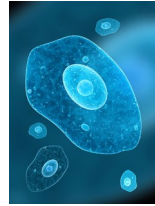

## Science

We will be learning about Humans and Animals, similarities and differences.

## English

## Maths

We will be learning to:

### Number and Calculation

- Children need to have learnt their 3, 4 & 8x tables by the end of Year Three.
- They need to be secure with place value to 100 and beyond, including tenths.
- We will be continuing with mental calculation strategies
- We will be continuing with written column addition & subtraction
- We will be learning about how data is represented by bar charts, pictograms
- We will be learning about 2D and 3D shape.
