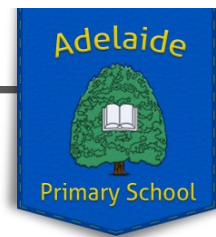

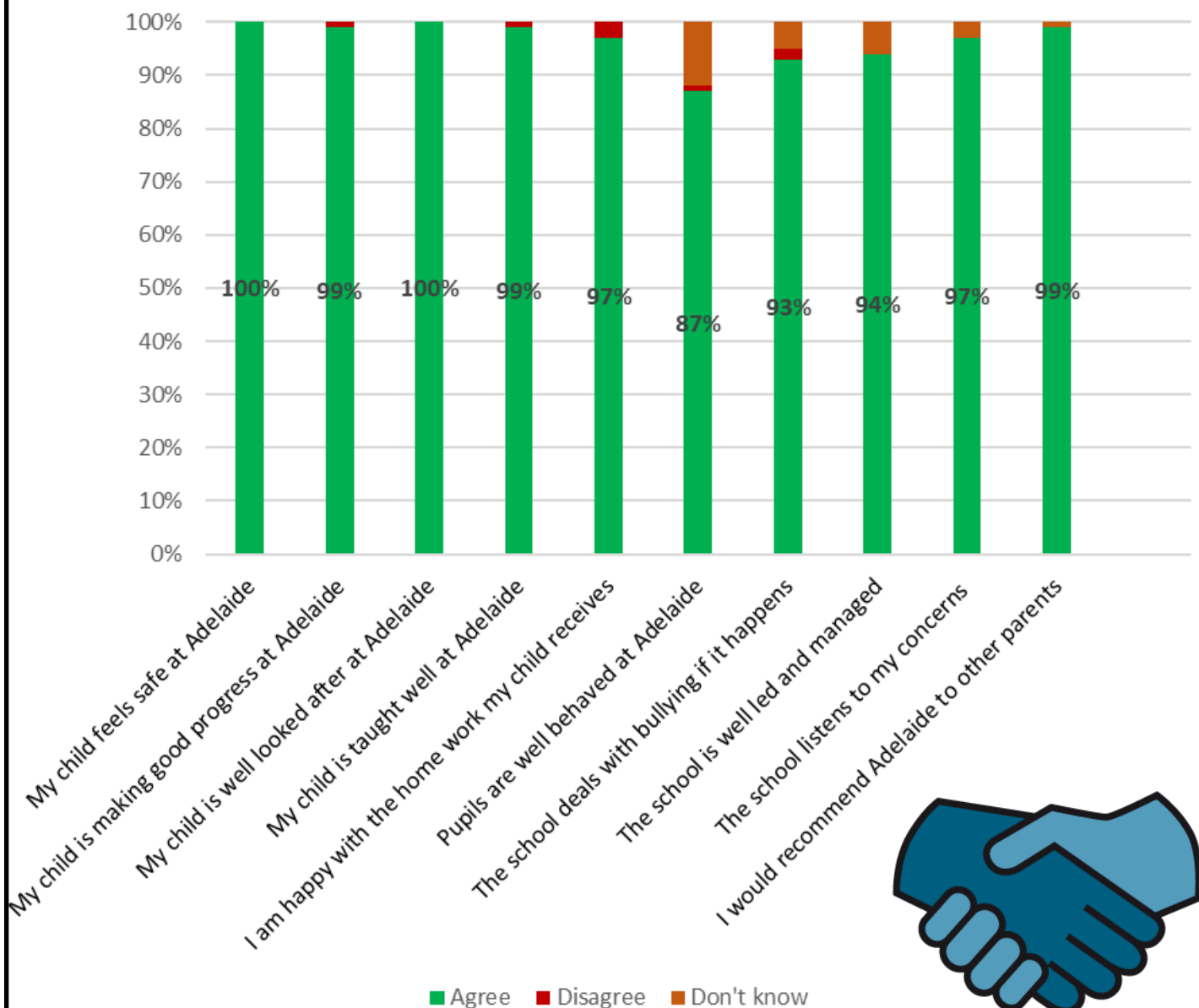
Parental Feedback
