

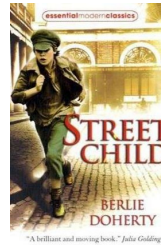

Literacy

- Write a story set in the past (Victorian times)
- Write a setting description (the workhouse) and a diary entry in the role of Jim
- Write poetry based on Michael Rosen / Charles Causley

Maths

- Read write and order numbers to 1,000,000
- Read Roman numerals to 1000
- Add, subtract, multiply and divide numbers with more than 4 digits, using formal written methods.



Science

- Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of gravity
- Identify the effects of air resistance
- Recognise that some mechanisms, including leavers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
