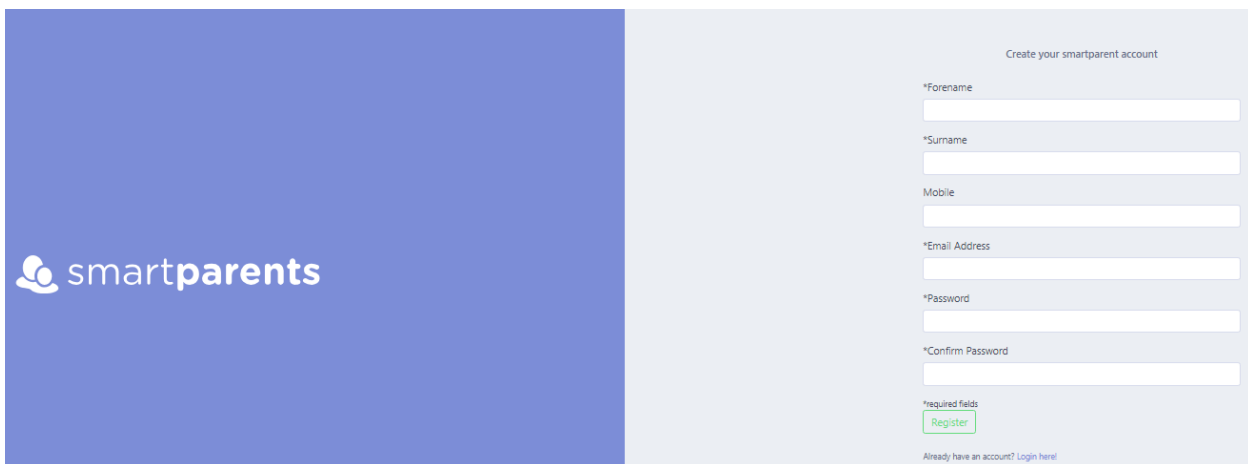

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Getting Started

Your child's school will issue you with details to associate children with your **account**.

Once you are registered you can log into your account by going to the [link](#).

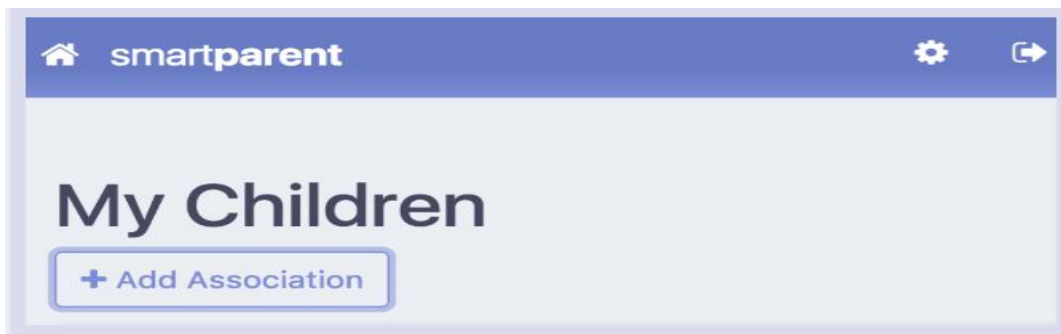
Adding Associations

Your child's school will send you a pin and a username for each of your children, once you have these details you can login and add each child to your account.

The data provided may look something like this:

First name	Last name	Year group	Username	Pin
Joe	Bloggs	7	myChildsUsername	pin123

Once you have this data, you can login and select Add Association.

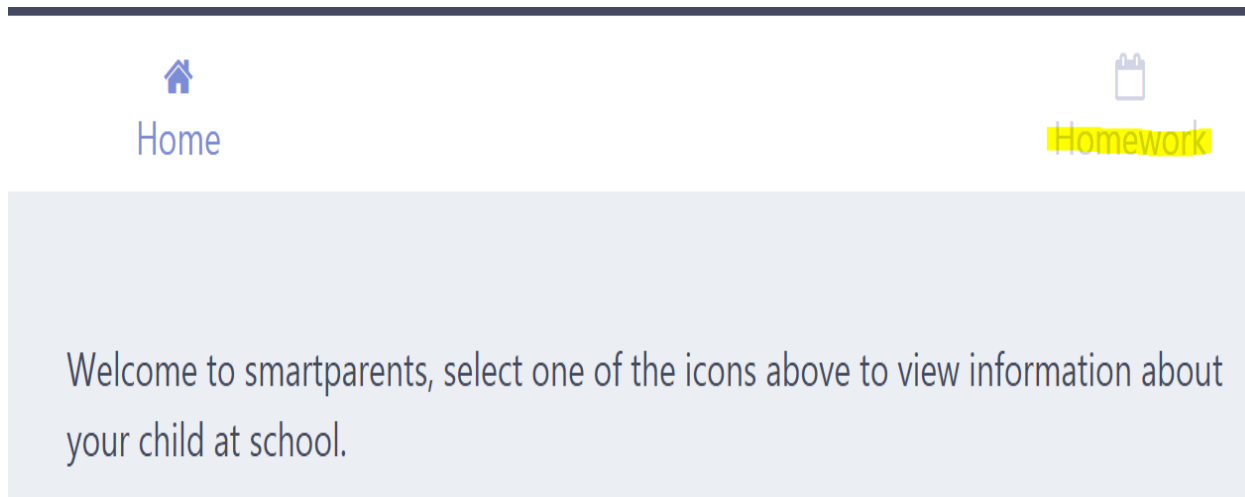


Now enter your child's Username, Pin and School in the boxes provided then click Add. If you enter the details correctly your child will now appear on the home page.

Viewing Homework

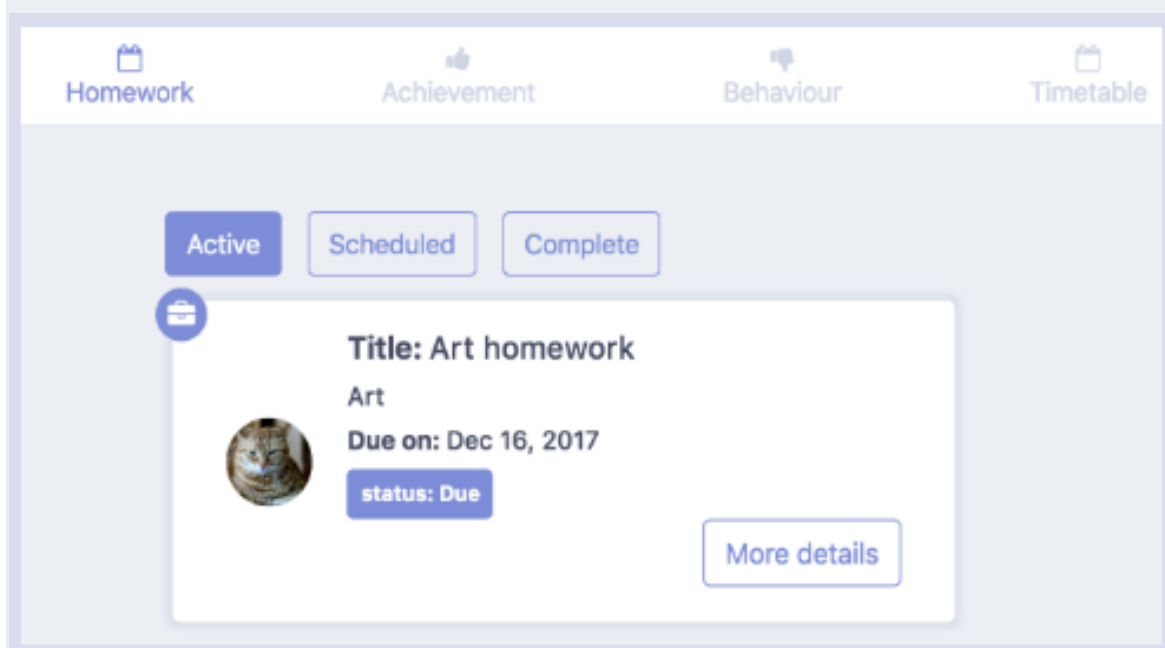
Select your child from your home page, and then click on the homework icon.



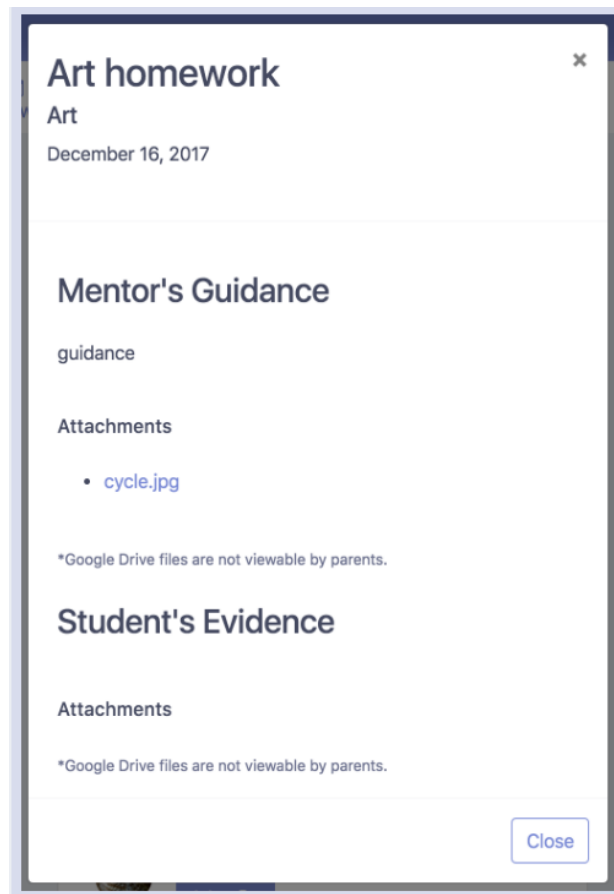
You will be able to see all of your child's homeworks that have been set using smarthomework.

You can navigate to:

- **Active** - Homework which is actively being completed by students, or being marked by teachers.
- **Scheduled** - Homework which is scheduled to be completed in the future.
- **Complete** - Homework that has been marked as complete by a teacher.



You can also select More Details, which will provide further detail on an individual homework
