HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT - OUR PARTNERSHIP

The aim of this document is to encourage us to work in a three way partnership in the confident knowledge that, by uniting as a home-school team, we shall be able to tackle any problems that may arise. This will ensure that students' learning is supported to help them achieve their best. By encouraging students to adhere to the school's behaviour and discipline policies we shall be preparing them for adult life, and in so doing, enhance the image of the school.

AS A PARENT OR CARER, I WILL:

1. ensure that my child attends school regularly, on time, properly dressed and equipped;
2. let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour;
3. support the school's policies and guidelines for learning and behaviour;
4. support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning;
5. make every effort to attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress;
6. get to know about my child's life at school.

SCHOOL WILL:

1. ensure that students follow the uniform code, take care of their surroundings and be thoughtful towards other people;
2. consult parents/carers when there is cause for concern;
3. encourage the students to do their best at all times;
4. set, mark and monitor homework and provide facilities for children to do homework in school;
5. inform parents/carers of the students' progress through termly grade sheets and the annual record of achievement;
6. keep parents/carers informed about school activities through regular letters home;
7. create an atmosphere of learning in which parents/carers will be welcome at any time;
8. ensure that students are safe and that the anti-bullying policy is adhered to.

STUDENTS WILL:

1. adhere to the uniform code both within and outside the school, respect the school and surrounding environment and ensure that they are good time managers;
2. seek help from relevant people when they have a concern;
3. abide by the school's demands for behaviour and learning;
4. complete homework tasks;
5. ensure that parents/carers receive relevant information from school.
