As the weather begins to warm up, our children need to be properly hydrated in Nursery. We are asking all children to bring in a **re-useable water bottle** with their name on, each day, so that they have a constant supply of water to drink. There will be areas in each group room where the children can keep their water bottles, but please remember to take them home and bring them back at the beginning and end of each session.

CLOTHING – Could you please make sure your child has a bag on their peg containing a change of clothing, and that all items of clothing are named. We are running short of spares so may not always be able to put your child into clean dry clothes. Also, remember to write your child's name in each item of clothing they wear – including shoes – so that lost items can be easily returned. Thank you!
